Dr. Baird attended the University of the Pacific (UOP) in Stockton, receiving her bachelor's degree in biology in 2005. She then attended UOP's Arthur A. Dugoni School of Dentistry in San Francisco, obtaining her Doctorate of Dental Surgery (DDS) in 2008. Following dental school, Dr. Baird practiced general dentistry while teaching at the dental school and completing a 27-month orthodontic residency at UOP.
